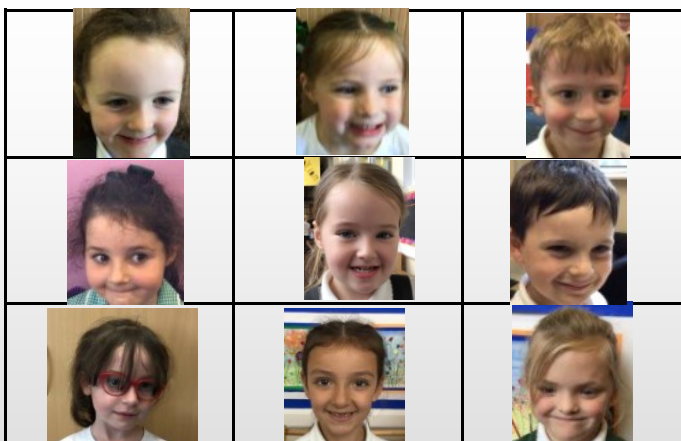

Fairtrade – Miss Webber



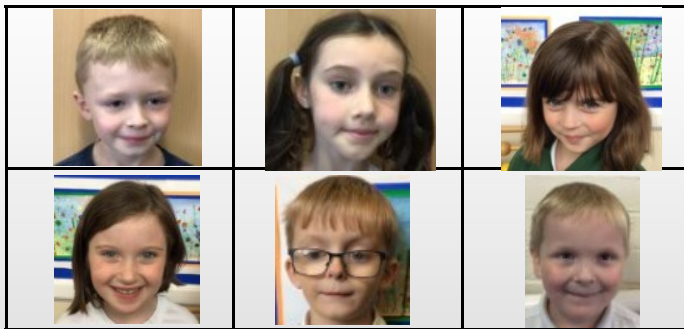
The children in our Fairtrade group are working to ensure we promote the values of Fair-trade throughout our school including equality, fairness and respect.

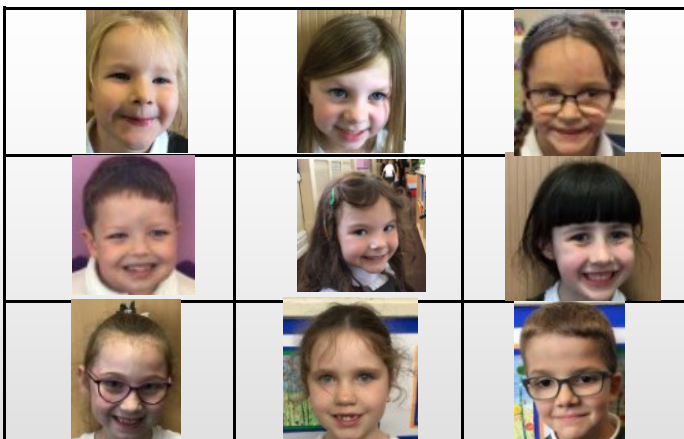
CAFOD Club—Miss Scragg

Arts Ambassadors– Mrs Jackson & Miss Tiffensor



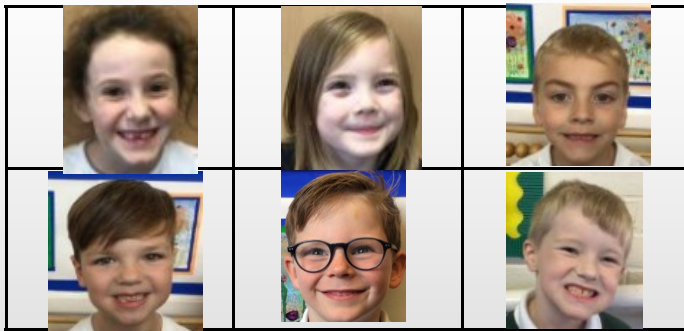

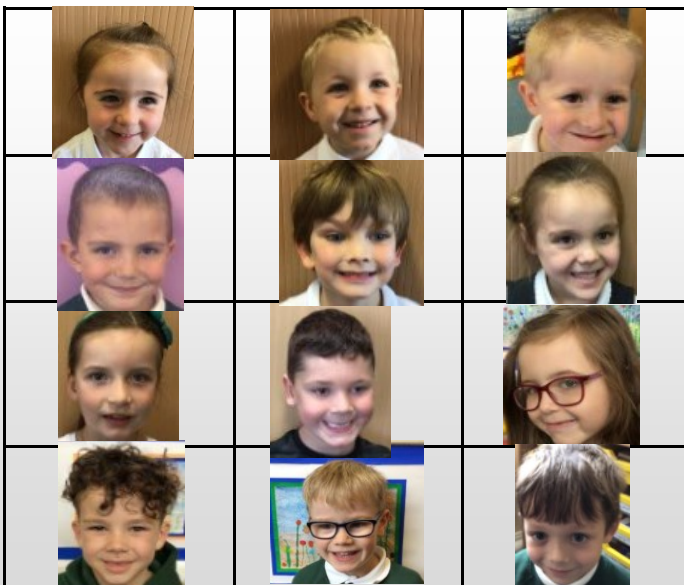
Sports Ambassadors—Mrs Bellard
