Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope this email finds you well and that you and your family are managing to keep safe.

I felt it was important after last night's statement from the Prime Minister to update and reassure you.

We have not received any information to support us with any plan to start the phased reopening of some year groups. We expect we will receive further information from the DfE over the next few days with some clarification.

Until we receive this further information from the Government on how to manage this possible phased return, there is currently no change to our school situation.

We will continue to provide care for children of critical key-workers and only those who cannot be safely cared for at home.

We expect that the DfE will provide schools with clarification over the next few days as we will need clear guidance on how to adhere to social distancing in school. **Our absolute priority is to ensure that our children, staff and families are safe.**

As always, we will keep you informed but for now, please try not to worry.

We cannot thank you enough for your ongoing support throughout these challenging and uncertain times. Please continue with Home Learning where possible...we have loved seeing all the children's work via email and on Twitter and we think you're all doing a fantastic job!
