Returning to school safely - September 2020

A guide for Year 1 and 2 parents



We look forward to welcoming our Year 1 and Year 2 children back to school in September and we are looking forward to welcoming our Reception children to our St Bede's family.



In order to keep everyone safe, we have a new system for arrival and collection from school. The time that your child starts and finishes school will also be different. This is to make sure that all adults can keep as much distance as possible on the playground and on the approach to school.



Each year group will have a different drop-off and pick-up time and each class will have a different entry point onto the playground.

Siblings

If you have 2 or more children in the Infant school in different year groups
(e.g. a child in Reception and a child in Year 2)

Arrival is 8:35am

Collection is 3:00pm

Sibling entrance and exit plan

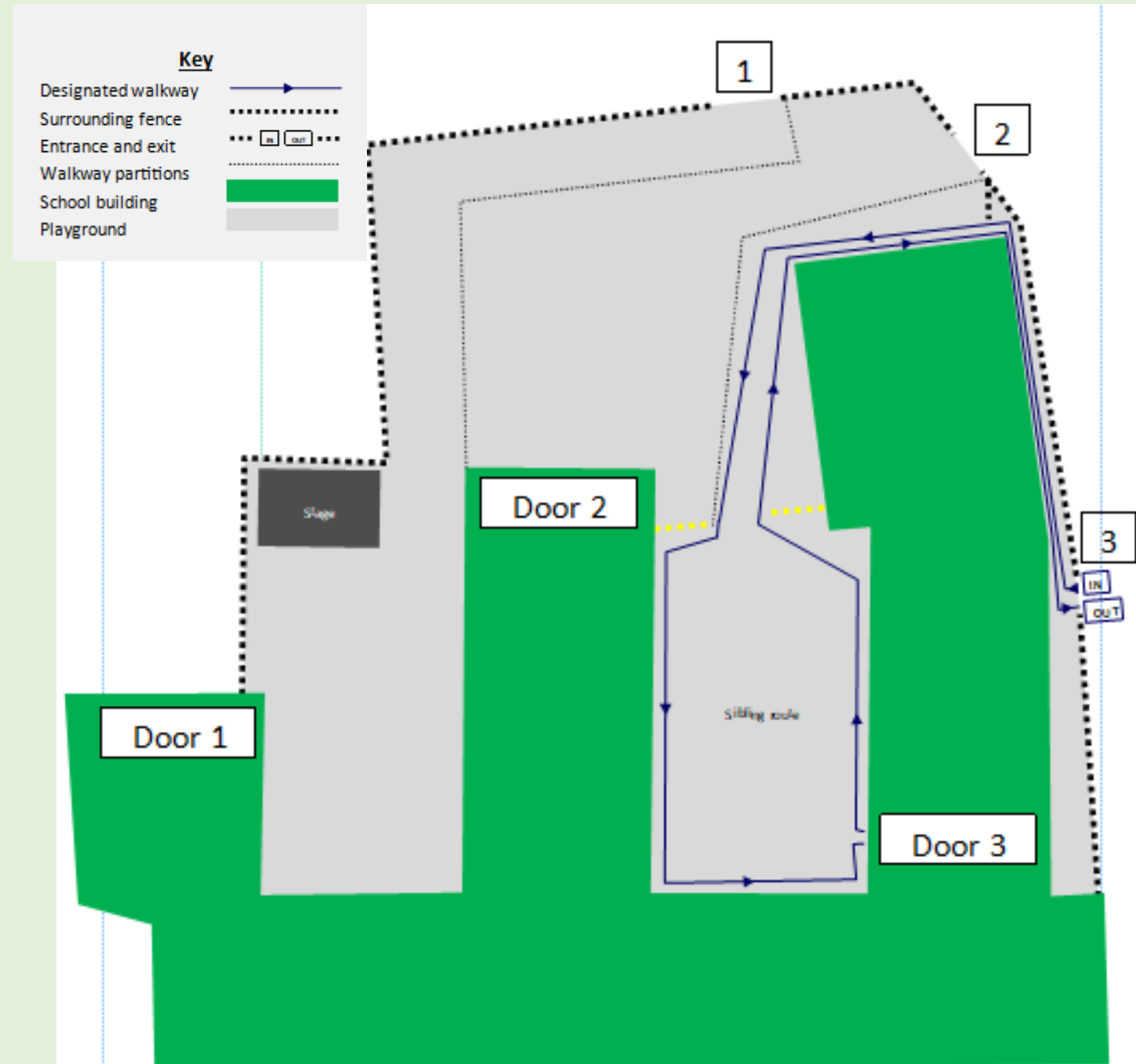
Times to be strictly adhered to, in order to maintain harmonious social distancing and continuous flow.

On arrival and departure, please use the school **gate 3**.

Follow the one-way route as indicated on this plan (see Key). Please ensure you adhere strictly to 2 metres social distancing whilst on the school site.

A member of staff will be waiting to greet your children at the allocated entrance as specified on the plan. You will also collect your children from the same door at the end of the day.

Year 2 entrance and exit plan

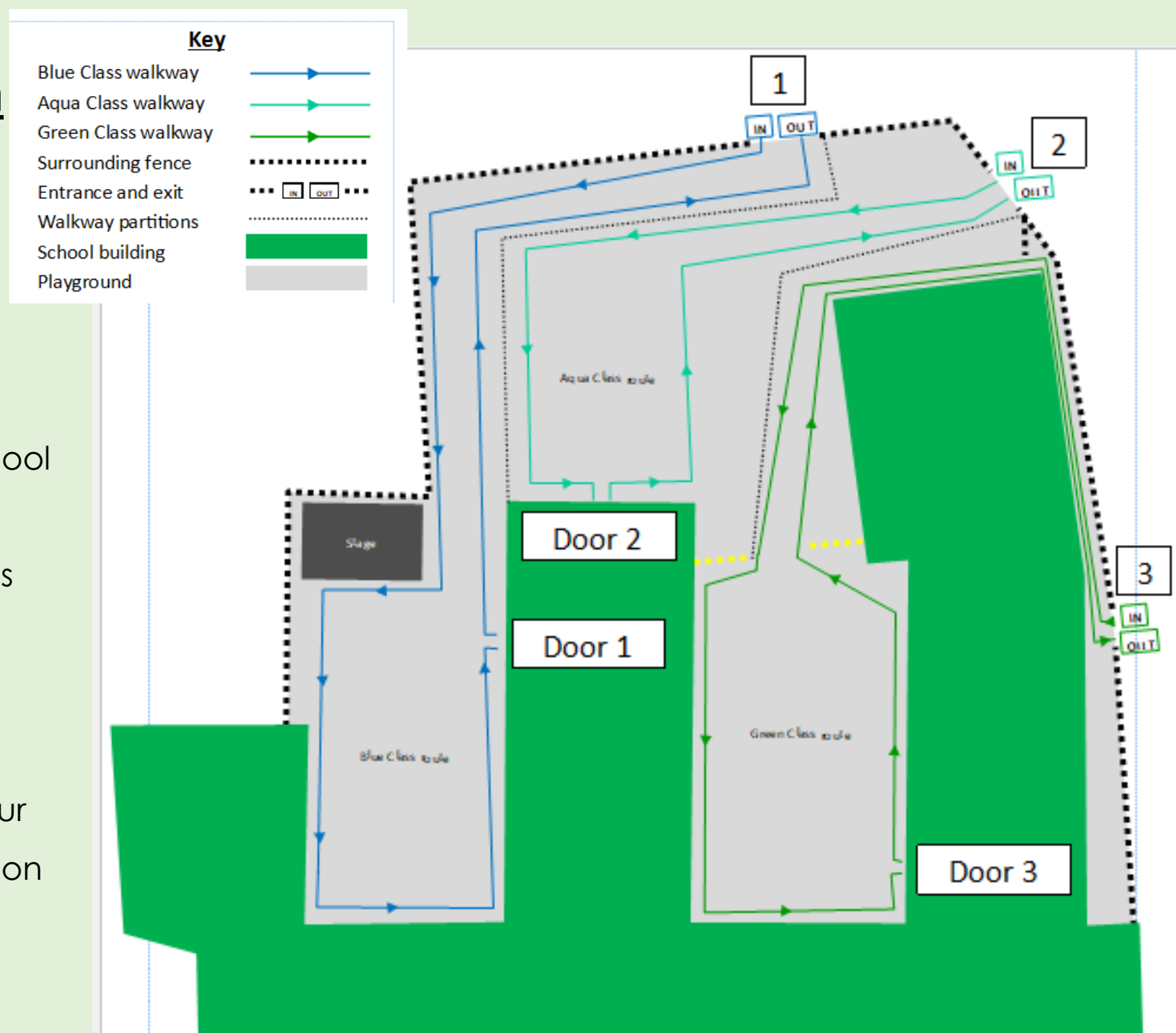
Times to be strictly adhered to, in order to maintain harmonious social distancing and continuous flow.

Year 1 entrance and exit plan

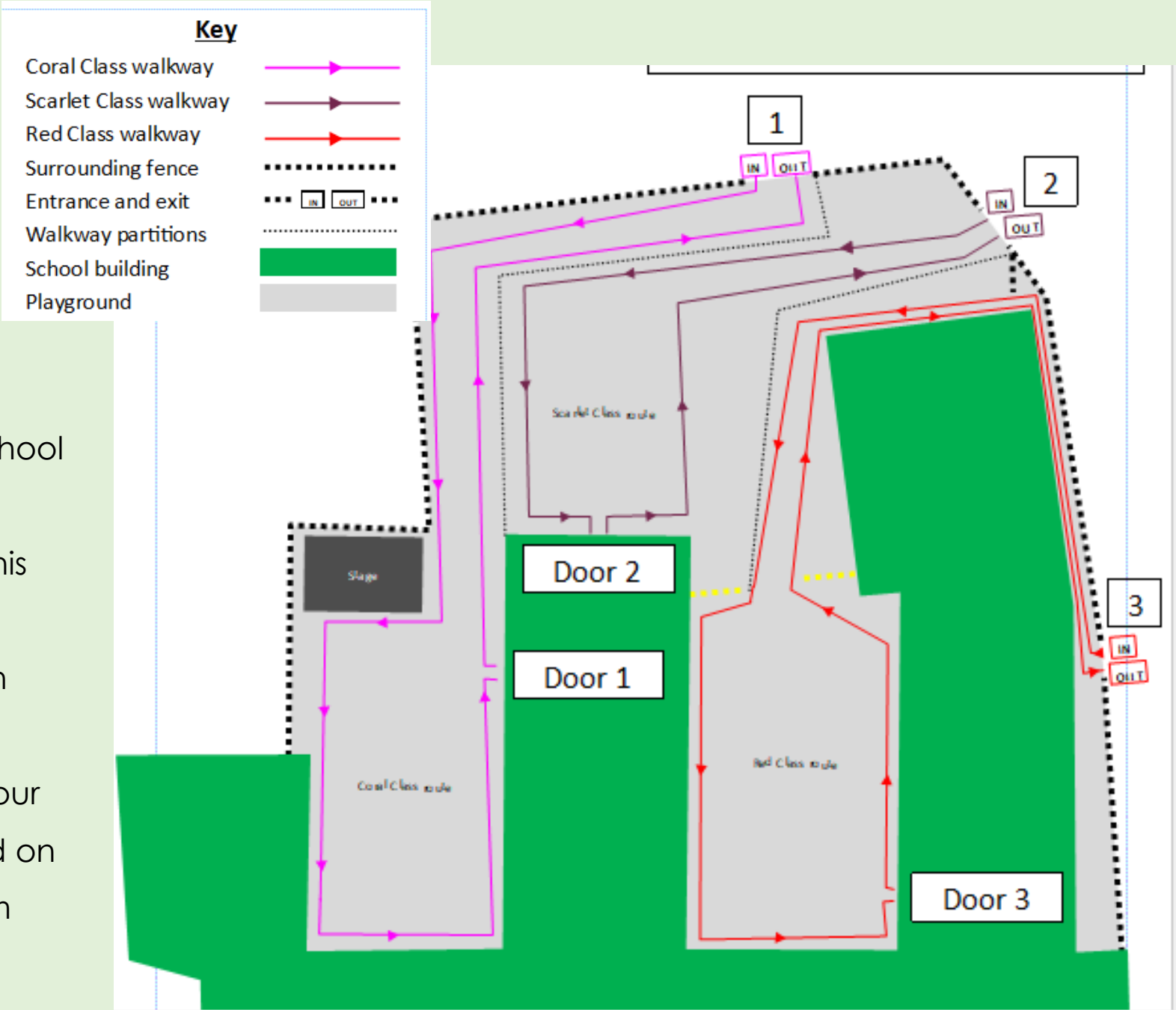
Times to be strictly adhered to, in order to maintain harmonious social distancing and continuous flow.

Please do not arrive early or

your child.

If you arrive early, please wait in your car or if on foot, somewhere away from the carpark until just before your child's designated arrival time.

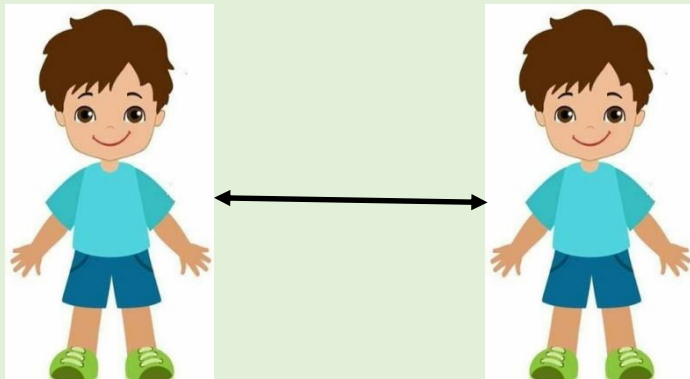
Please remember that all these measures are in place for everyone's safety.

General Information

- Children should wear school uniform
- Children should not bring anything in from home other than:
 - Book bag (No large bags or attachments e.g. key rings/ornaments)
 - reading book/reading diary/home school book
 - Water bottle
 - Packed lunch

Keeping our school Covid-safe

Temporary rules to keep us safe in school will be followed from September.



Don't get too close to each other.
Don't touch each other.

Wash your hands regularly, for 20 seconds, using soap and water.

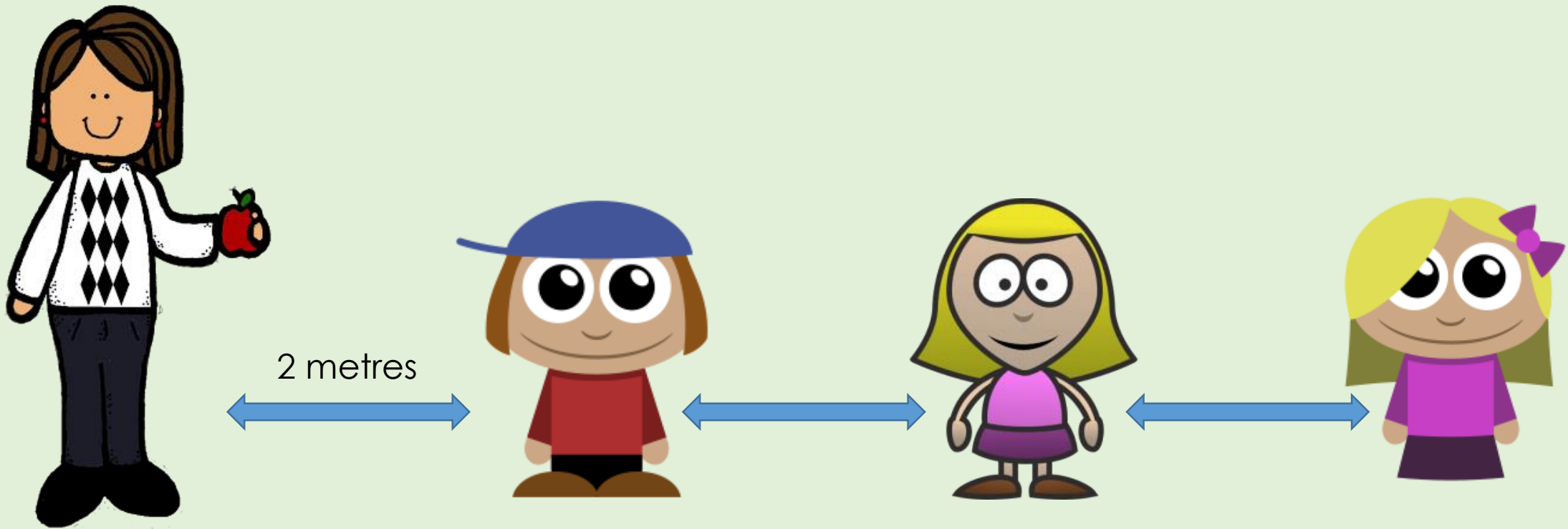


Listen carefully to all of the instructions from the adults.



Keep apart when you are lining up.

Always keep 2 metres apart from the adults.



Cover your mouth when you cough or sneeze.

You should try to cough or sneeze into your elbow.

Use a tissue and then put it in one of our 'Catch It, Bin It, Kill It' bins.

CATCH IT

Germs spread easily. Always carry tissues and use them to catch your cough or sneeze.



BIN IT

Germs can live for several hours on tissues. Dispose of your tissue as soon as possible.



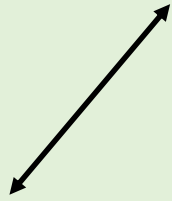
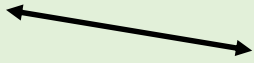
KILL IT
