




Day of Prayer-8th March 2024








We mark off the way we travel to or from to school each week. We love to see when we have earned our badges. We love to collect the badges each month.

Our Community Day 1st July 2023





We have two community days each year. In October and July.





Some of the pledges to care for and protect our Common Home. They were completed by families who attended one of our Collective Worships.











Everyone should have a say

Faith in Action and Live Simply 2024


Community Links – St Bede's Catholic Infant School and Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic High School.
