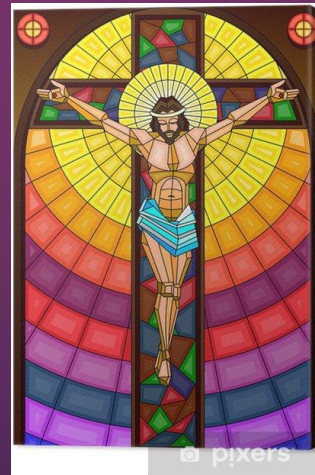



Good Friday



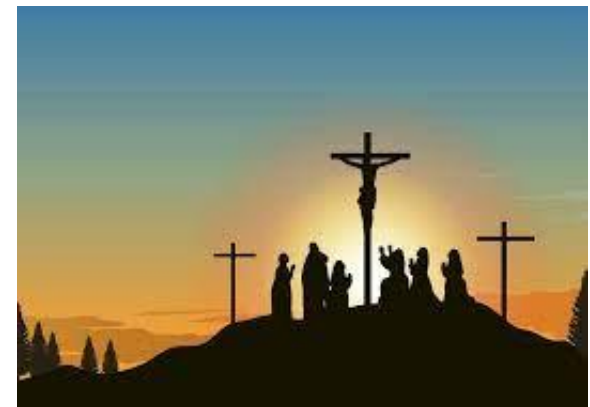
On Good Friday Jesus died on the cross. It was a very sad day.

When Jesus died 2 of his friends, wrapped up his body and buried it in a garden cave.

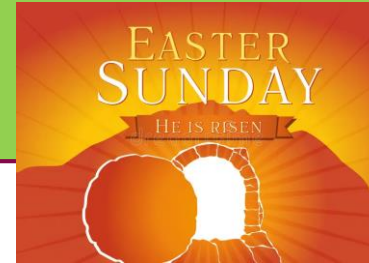
They rolled a huge stone across the opening. Some soldiers stood guard in front of the cave.
