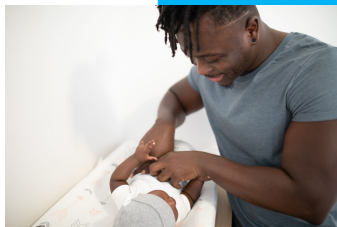

# Talk to me at bathtime


Bath time is a great time to develop your child's speech, language and communication skills.



 Talk about what you can see, hear and smell (e.g. dripping taps, smelly soap, big bubbles).

 Playing with toys in the bath is so much fun and a great opportunity to talk about sinking and floating.

 Create a pouring station with lots of different sized plastic bottles, jugs, cups and bowls and talk about what you are doing (e.g. pouring, full, empty).

 Talk about different body parts as you encourage your child to wash their body (e.g. soap on your arms, soap on your chin, soap on your ankle).
